

As we celebrate the retirement of three of our most respected providers, it's not lost on us the innovation, legacy, and history they leave behind. For that, we are grateful.




### MARK KODAY, CHIEF DENTAL OFFICER

Dr. Koday: We hope you enjoy the next chapter of your life, you deserve it.




### DON LASSELLE, OBGYN

Dr. Lasselle: we offer, from the bottom of our hearts, a sincere thank you, enjoy your retirement!




### JOHN NAIDEN, OBGYN

We hope your retirement is as restful as your career was long.


