The health center will provide medical, dental, and pharmacy services, all under one roof with design features that aim to support better access and seamless service.

Miramar Health Center, Kennewick will be accepting patients with Medicare, Medicaid, private insurance, and cash pay. We also have dedicated staff helping patients enroll in health insurance.
